Finance:

Gala goal \$80,000, to date raised \$74,000 not including expenses. Reviewed live and silent auction results, raffles. Overall, event was a great success and fun had by all! Areas for improvement: night ended an hour early, need for improved sound system, more inclusive menu to accommodate for common dietary restrictions, discussed ways to increase donations in the future. Jerry will provide feedback back to the Gala committee.

Christmas tree sales will start later this month. Christmas raffle will be distributed to SJS families next week with a goal of \$10,000.
